The frameless luminous surface LIGHT FIELDS III and the minimalist office luminaire ECOOS II are all-rounders when it comes to complex office lighting. SUPERSYSTEM integral collection offers an extensive portfolio of carefully miniaturised lighting tools that provide a high-quality solution for numerous architectural lighting tasks.

### **LIGHT FIELDS III – master of demanding visual tasks**

Rooms and workplaces are perfectly illuminated by the third generation of the LIGHT FIELDS family. The frameless body allows full integration into the architecture and thus endlessly flexible room design. The full-sized luminous surface is the defining feature of the new luminaire generation. "Unlimited, frameless, simply light", says Stefan Ambrozus from [Studio Ambrozus](#), describing the design he helped create. It allows luminaires to be easily arranged in sequence, providing perfect lighting for large rooms in particular. A special feature of the luminaire is the MPO+ optic: the light is refracted, guided and suitably distributed in a controlled manner. This creates precise lighting that is particularly suitable for office work.

### **ECOOS II – 360-degree light redefined**

The ECOOS product family is in a class of its own. The linear second-generation luminaire, with its minimalist design, offers unique 360° lighting for large office spaces and is therefore also ideally suited to use in educational establishments or in a healthcare setting. The innovative Curved Waveguide technology makes the luminaires look as if they are floating and ensures that light is evenly distributed throughout the space. It looks almost endless and three-dimensional. Thanks to tunableWhite, the amount of white in the light can be individually adjusted depending on the daylight and on requirements. This invites people to communicate, carry out concentrated work or be inspired.

### **SUPERSYSTEM integral collection – first-class. Linear. Everlasting.**

[SUPERSYSTEM integral collection](#) was designed by leading Austrian design office [EOOS](#) and is a spectacular lighting tool for all aspects of architectural lighting. As the name suggests, the

SUPERSYSTEM integral collection integrates all the options in a clear design concept. A single portfolio offers adjustable accent lighting with spotlights or linear gimbal luminaires, horizontal lighting with recessed luminaires and vertical lighting with perfect wallwashing and pleasant indirect light.

### **About the Red Dot Design Award**

The [Red Dot Design Award](#), established in Essen, has been honouring excellent design since 1955. The international prize for product and communication design is awarded by the Design Zentrum Nordrhein-Westfalen in Essen and is divided into three prize categories: product design, design agencies and design concepts. The products, brands, communication work and concepts submitted for the Red Dot Design Award are assessed by a jury made up of independent designers, design academics and specialist journalists. The prize-winning designs are presented online and in a yearbook, and exhibited in the three Red Dot Design museums, at the Zollverein Coal Mine Industrial Complex in Essen, in Singapore and in Xiamen, China, at the same time. Zumtobel won its first design prize in 1963. And has continued to win prizes since then.

### **About the iF DESIGN AWARD**

The [iF DESIGN AWARD](#) has been a globally recognised hallmark of excellent design for 67 years. The iF brand is internationally established as a symbol of excellent design. This time round, the 78-person independent jury group had to evaluate 7,298 entries from 56 nations, with 1,453 designers, agencies and companies now still in the running to receive an iF DESIGN AWARD in 2020. The iF DESIGN AWARD awards prizes for design achievements in all disciplines: product, packaging, communication and service design, architecture, interior design and professional concepts. Zumtobel won its first design prize in 1963. The company continues to win awards on a regular basis.
